Reading aloud to children develops their vocabulary, comprehension and provides a model for fluency. Around 75 per cent of our vocabulary comes from our reading. Reading and writing are reciprocal so exposure to a rich range of texts will impact on both speaking and writing. This document is a bank of fiction, poetry and non-fiction that the children at St Anne's will engage with throughout their time at the school.

Pie Corbett's reading spine; CLPE - centre for Literacy in Primary Education; Books for topics; the 5 plagues of the developing reader.


