Year 2 visit to Watercress Farm, - Tuesday 13th January 2026

We are excited to let you know that Year 2 will be visiting Watercress Farm, as part of The Belmont Estate for the second of 3 visits over this academic year on **Tuesday 13th January** as part of our enquiry – *How can we help?* The children will have the opportunity to connect with nature and build on their knowledge and appreciation of the natural world, helping them to understanding the cause and effects human behaviour can have on our environment. Through this understanding, children will learn to protect and help grow nature and foster better habits.

Details of the trip:

- **Time:** The coach will be leaving school at 9am and returning by 2.30pm
- **Location:** Watercress Farm, BS48 1NE
- **Clothing:** Please ensure your child wears warm clothing as we will be outdoors all day and it will be cold. Waterproof coat and trousers, if they have them, and welly boots. Children will need a **full** change of clothes (including underwear and socks) as the site is muddy and they will need to change before returning to the coach.

The children will NOT be entering the river on this trip.

- **Cost: Due to successful fundraising, this trip requires no additional contributions from parents.**
